

PatternPress printing guide

Before you order your print

1. Open the exported PDF and inspect every page join.
2. Tell the print shop: print at 100% / actual size. Never fit to page.
3. A0 output uses 841 x 1189 mm sheets, with 10 mm margins.
4. Multiple A0 sheets overlap by 10 mm. Match the repeated lines.
5. For a single large sheet, ask the shop to check its exact dimensions.
6. Print the original pattern test square first and measure it with a ruler.
7. Compare that test square on the final print before cutting fabric.

Remember

PatternPress preserves scale; it cannot verify the designer's scale.

All size layers are included. Layer selection is not supported yet.

Trim values are applied equally to all four sides of every selected page.

Check the layout and overlap instructions supplied by the pattern designer.

Keep your original PDF. Use patterns you own or have permission to use.
